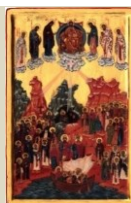

1 St. Beatus of Lungern

Apostle to Switzerland
Born in England- supposedly baptized there by St. Barnabas
and ordained in Rome by St. Peter (!???)
Died ~112
Feast Day 9 May
Initial travels to Windisch AG area via Roman road, then to Thun
Grave in Beatus Caves in Beatenberg, CH
Chapel in Lungren
Some suggest his life in the 600's, which has
a much more practical sound to it



2 Bl. Achates

Companion of St. Beatus
Died ~118
FD 10 May
Buried next to St. Beatus by some accounts

3 St. Lucius of Chur, BM

Reported first Bishop of Chur, but most believe that was 150 yrs. later
Confusion with St. Lucius of Britain
Martyred 176 (or maybe 5/6th-century)
Feast Day 3 Dec
Relics in St. Luzikirche in Chur



4 St. Emerita, VM

Reported sister of St. Lucius
Born England?
Died 4/5/6th-century Trimmis, Graubünden
Feast Day 4 Dec
Queen, virgin, martyr
Relics in St. Luzikirche in Chur

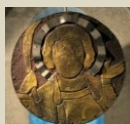


5 St. Columba of Sens, VM

Cave in Jura on River Sornegau near Undervelier
Born in Zaragoza (or France)
Died 273/274 Sens, France
Feast Day 31 Dec
Historical, but acts are suspect

6 St. Pelagius of Constance, M

Patron saint of Constance
Born 270
Died 283
Feast Day 28 August
Child martyr put to death in Pannonia (current Austria)



Martyrs of Agaunum (aka the Theban Legion)

From Thebes, Egypt
Commanded by St. Maurice
520 to 6,666 men
Martyred 286/7 c.a.
Feast Day 22 Sept
Relics enshrined in Basilica of Agaunum
Known members of the Legion:



7 St. Alexander of Bergamo- perhaps escaped for a while- Italy
St. Candidus the Theban (Candide). Relics Saint Maurice. Senator Militum

8 St. Chiaffredo of Saluzzo- escaped to Piedmont, Italy were martyred
St. Exuperius- body found 515 and brought St. Maurice, CH, reburied in 1225,
main relics now in Saluzzo, IT (?). Campidoctor

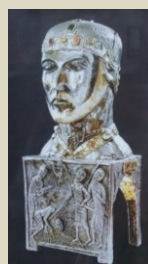
9 St. Fortunatus of Casei- Escaped to be martyred in 300 c.a.?, info from
Internet, not listed in H or SV. FD 16 Oct.

10 St. Innocent of Agaunum- May have survived- relics at Saint-Maurice.

11 St. Maurice (Mauritius, Moritz). Relics Saint Maurice. Leader
St. Secundus the Theban, escaped but caught in Italy, FD 26 Aug

St. Ursus the Theban (of Solothurn)- separate listing

St. Victor of Agaunum- Civilian passing by



St. Victor of Xanten, Relics in Xanten, DE
 St. Victor the Theban (of Solothurn)- separate listing
 St. Vitalis of Agaunum- May have survived

Others associated to the Legion:

St. Antoninus of Piacenza- associated by later story tellers
 St. Adventor of Turin- associated by later story tellers
 St. Cassius- may have been a member, associated with Gereon; Bonn, DE
 St. Florentius the Martyr- may have been a member, associated with Gereon: Bonn, DE
 St. George of San Giorio- associated by later story tellers
 St. Gereon- not a member, but a martyr never-the-less
 St. Octavius of Turin- associated by later story tellers
 St. Pons of Pradlevs- escaped and evangelized in northern Italy
 St. Secundus of Asti- associated due to art
 St. Solutor of Turin- associated by later story tellers
 St. Tiberio of Pinerolo- may have been a member

Associated with the Theban Legion by legend
 Martyred with companions at Vils near Sitten
 Feast Day 9 Dec



13 St. Nicasius, M

Of Theban Legion fame
 Feast Day 22 Sept
 Schötz, CH

14 St. Felix, M

15 St. Regula, M

Brother and sister
 Associated with the Theban Legion
 Escaped Agaunum, but captured in Zurich
 Martyred 286 with servant Exuperantius
 Feast Day 11 Sept
 The three of them on the Coat of Arms of Zurich
 Relics in Church of Felix and Regula, Hardstrasse 76, Zurich
 Relics in Church of Sts. Peter and Paul in Andermatt



16 St. Exuperantius, M

Servant of Felix and Regula
 Martyred with them in 286
 FD 11 Sept
 The three of them on the Coat of Arms of Zurich
 No relics of Exuperantius known to exist

17 St. Victor of Solothurn, M

Martyred 286 c.a.
 Feast Day 30 Sept
 Relics moved to Geneva 473-500 by Queen Theudesinde
 Also, have seen by Princess Sedeleuba, a sister of Queen Clotilda
 She had a basilica built for his relics, relics destroyed during P-revolution



18 St. Ursus of Solothurn, M

Martyred 286 c.a.
 Feast Day 30 Sept
 Relics in the Cathedral Treasury



Martyrs of Nyon

Martyred under Diocletian
 Martyred at Nyon (Nivedunam), CH (or Neuvy, FR)
 Died 303
 Feast Day 4 June (formally) 8 June now?
 Leader Zoticus, Dinocus (not sure he belongs), Attalus, Euticus (Eutyichius), Camasus,
 Quirinus, Julia, Saturninus, Galdunus, Ninnita, Fortunio, Cyrinus (Cyrina), Ebustus,
 Rusticus, Silvius + 25 companions
 Artemius
 Calcorus and Heracdius at Novidunum

Feast Day 17/26 Sept

20 St. Valerianus

21 St. Gordianus

22 St. Macrinus

Great confusion as to how many and the names of those actually martyred at Nyon.

Reported first Bishop of Basel- not historical
 Died 304 (or 452)
 Feast Day 12 Oct
 Supposed Martyr
 Not much known
 Relic of his skull associated with St. Ursula of Cologne
 Relic in Mariastein



- 24 St. Verena of Zurzach, V
 From Thebes, Egypt. Associated with Theban Legion
 Born 260 c.a.
 Died 320
 Feast Day 1 Sept
 Shrine die Vernakapelle, Solothurn
 Tomb in the Church in Bad Zurzach

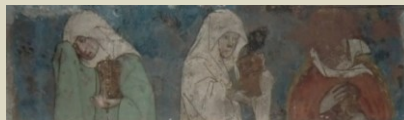


- 25 St. Kunigunde (Cunegonde, Cunigundis) of Rapperswil
 Companion of St. Ursula
 Died 325 c.a. Rapperswil, CH or Eichsel (Rheinfelden), Baden, DE
 Feast Day 17 June
 Relics in Church of St. Gallus in Eichsel, DE



- 26 St. Mechtundis of Rapperswil
 Companion of St. Ursula
 Died 325 c.a. Rapperswil, CH or Eichsel (Rheinfelden), Baden, DE
 Feast Day 17 June
 Relics in Church of St. Gallus in Eichsel, DE

- 27 St. Wibrandis of Rapperswil
 Servant of Kunigunde and Mechtundis
 Died 325 c.a. Rapperswil, CH or Eichsel (Rheinfelden), Baden, DE
 Feast Day 17 June
 Relics in Church of St. Gallus in Eichsel, DE



- 28 St. Christina (Chrischona)
 Companion of St. Ursula- somehow related to above three
 Born in England?
 Died 4/5-th century Dinkelberg, Basel, CH
 Feast Day 16 June

- 29 St. Sempronius, B
 Missionary Bishop and Apostle to Valais
 Time of 347 c.a.
 From Italy

- 30 St. Aquilo (Aquilonius), C
 FD 19 Oct Formally venerated in Geneva.
 Very little information available.

- 31 St. Theodulus (1 of 3), B
 First Bishop of Valais/Sion
 Died 391
 Feast Day 17 (16) Aug
 Also, called Theodore of Grammont or Octodurus
 or St. Yoder (Joder)
 Build church over Theban martyrs
 Relics in Ottobeuren, DE, perhaps



- 32 St. Elias, B her
 Reported Bishop of Sitten (Sion, Sedunum) in Valais (Wallis)
 Resigned to solitary life on the Isle of Giuliano, Orta Lake, Diocese of Navara
 Died beginning of 5th-century
 Feast Day 21 March



- 33 St. Florentinus of Sion, BM
 Somewhat mystical bishop of Sion
 Reported to have been martyred in c.a. 411 by the Vandals.
 Feast Day 27 Sept
 Might have been a hermit with Hilarius in Roman Gaul
 and who were martyred there



- 34 St. Hilarius, dea M
 Reported to have been a deacon to St. Bishop Florentinus of Sion (above)
 Reported to have been martyred in c.a. 411 by the Vandals.

Feast Day 27 Sept
Might have been a hermit with Florentinus in Roman Gaul
and who were martyred there

- 35 St. Isaac of Geneva, B
First bishop of Geneva 400 c.a.
From a letter of St. Eucherius to Salvius



- 36 St. Asimo, B
First historical Bishop of Chur
Bishop of Chur 452-455
Died ~455
Feast Day 19 Jan
Tomb in Cathedral of Chur



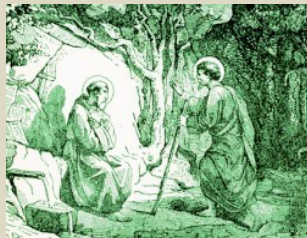
- 37 St. Parilius (Purilius, Prurilius), B
Reported 2nd Bishop of Chur
Lived ~460
Feast Day 9 June

- 38 St. Salonius, BC
Second Bishop of Geneva 440
Son of St. Eucherius of Lyon
Born 400 c.a.
Died 475
Feast Day 28 Sept

- 39 St. Silvius (Salvius), CB
Bishop of Valais at Agaunum (Octodurum)
Died 462 c.a.
Feast Day 30 April
Some potential to be the Abbot of Agaunum,
before the reconstruction (434-449)



- 40 St. Romanus of Condat, abbot
Abbot of Condat (now St. Claude)
Hermit in Jura Mountains
Born 390 c.a.
Died 463
Feast Day 28/29 Feb
Founded three monasteries with his brother St. Lupicinus, one
being the great Romainmôtier Monastery in Vaud.
Buried at La Beaume, now Saint-Romain-de-Roch



- 41 St. Maximus of Turin, B
First Bishop of Turin
Born 380 c.a. Rhaetia area now part of CH
Died 466
Feast Day 25 June



- 42 St. Valentine of Rhaetia (Passau), B her
Missionary Bishop to Rhaetia, later hermit
Died 475 in Tyrol, Austria
Feast Day 7 Jan
Relics in St. Stephan Passau, DE



- 43 St. Lupicinus, C abbot her
Brother of St. Romanus
Hermit in Jura Mountains
Died 21 Mar 480
Buried Lauconne (now Saint-Lupicin)
Feast day 21 March



- 44 St. Pontius (Point), monk her
Monk at Condat
Lived 5th-century, died say 480
Feast Day 23 May
Founded hermitage on Lake Joux, Le Lieu, VD

- 45 St. Severinus of Agaunum, abbot
Abbot of Agaunum, before the reconstruction
His prayers healed King Clovis I of the gout
Born in Burgundy, FR



Died 507 in Paris
Feast day 11 Feb



- 46 St. Hymnemund, abbot
First abbot of St. Maurice
Died 516
Feast Day 3 Jan



- 47 St. Ambrose of Agaunum, abbot
Second Abbot of St. Maurice
Died 520
Feast Day 2 Nov
Real leader in restoring the monastery



- 48 St. Achivus, abbot
Third Abbot of St. Maurice
Died 523
Feast Day 29 March

- 49 St. Sigismund of Burgundy, M roy
King of Burgundy
Founded Monastery of St. Maurice in Agaunum
Born 474 c.a. Burgundy, FR
Died 524
Feast Day 1 May
Martyr
Relics at Cathedral in Prague and Saint-Maurice, CH



- 50 St. Gistald (Gistalan), M
Son of St. Sigismund
Died 524
Relics at Abbey of St. Maurice, Valais
Feast Day 1 May



- 51 St. Gundebald, M
Son of St. Sigismund
Died 524
Relics at Abbey of St. Maurice, Valais
Feast Day 1 May

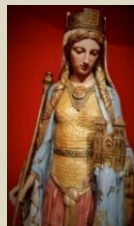
- 52 St. Tranquillinus, abbot
Abbot of St. Maurice, Valais
Died 525
Feast Day 13 Dec

- 53 St. Fridolin, C abbot
Born in Ireland
Died 540 c.a.
Feast Day 6 March
Relics in Church in Bad Sackingen, DE
Often seen with skeleton he raised from the dead
On the flag of Glarus



- 54 St. Maximus, B
Bishop of Geneva 512-41
Died 541

- 55 St. Chlothildis, Queen of the Franks
Married to King Clovis of the Franks
Born 474, Lyon
Died 3 June 545, Tours
Feast Day 3 June
Spent much of her childhood in Geneva
Primarily responsible for her husband's conversion



- 56 St. Valentinianus, B
Bishop of Chur 530-548
Born 480
Died 12 Jan 548/9
Feast Day 9 Sept
Tomb in Cathedral of Chur

- 57 St. Placidus, C abbot
Abbot of St. Maurice, Valis

Died 548 c.a.
Feast Day 5 May

- 58 St. Theodulus of Sion (2 of 3), B
Bishop of Sion
Died 550 c.a.
Feast Day 27 Aug
Restored Church over Theban Legion martyrs with King Sigismund

- 59 St. Paulus, abbot
Abbot of St. Maurice at time of Pope Pelagius I
Lived 560 c.a.
Feast Day 15 May
Raise a boy from the dead

- 60 St. Hilary (Heliodorus), CB
Bishop of Valais
Died 585 c.a.
Transferred see from Octodurum to Sion in 589

- 61 St. Guntram, roy
King of the Franks, Ruler of Burgandy (included much of CH)
Born ~525
Died 28 Mar 593
Feast Day 28 Mar
Peace-loving and mild, though rather "David-like" earlier in life



- 62 St. Marius (Marie) Aventicensis (of Avenches), CB
Bishop of Avenches (Lausanne) (574-596)
Moved Diocese from Avenches to Lausanne in about 585
Born 530 Diocese of Autun
Died 31 Dec 594
Feast Day 31 Dec
Buried in St. (Basilica?) Thyrsus in Lausanne- Cannot find church



- 63 St. Gaudentius von Casaccia, priest, M
Preached in the Rhaetian Alps (Grissons)
Exact era is unknown: 4th-7th centuries
Killed at Casaccia in the Bergell valley- church there in his honor
Cult approved by Pope Urban IV in 1262
Feast Day 2 Aug, now 22 Jan



- 64 St. Marinus, abbot
Abbot of St. Maurice and Lerins
Died early 600's
Feast Day 1 Jan

- 65 St. Columban(us), abbot
From Ireland
Born 559
Died 615 Bobbio Abbey, IT
Feast Day 23 Nov
Founded Luxeuil Monastery in Belgium
Traveled through Switzerland 611-612
Undervelier in Jura Mountains?
Relics in Einsiedlen, body in Bobbio, IT



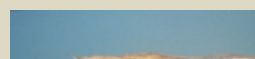
- 66 St. Ursicinus, CF her

Born 552 Ireland?
Died 620
Feast Day 20 Dec
Founded St. Ursanne
Buried at what is today St. Ursanne in Juras



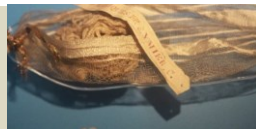
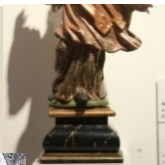

Buried Bonfol, CH



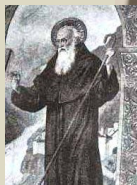
- 68 St. Himerius (Imerius) of Immortal, C her
Hermit in Jura Mountains



Born 570 c.a. Lugnez, Jura
 Died 612
 Feast Day 12 Nov (13 Nov)
 Monastery built over tomb in Saint-Imier



- 69 St. Attala, C abbot
 Follower of St. Columban
 Born in Ireland or Burgundy
 Died 10 Mar 626 Bobbio, IT
 Traveled through Switzerland 611-612
 Second abbot of Bobbio



- 70 St. Ragnachar (Ruchnaris, Racho, Ragner), B
 First Bishop of Basel after removal of See from Augusta Rauracorum about 618
 Died 620- 639
 Feast Day 29 March (5 Dec)
 From Luxeuil



- 71 St. Amatus (Amato, Aime, Amé) of Saint Maurice, C abbot her
 30 yrs. at St. Maurius Abbey- student, monk, hermit
 First hermit at Notre-Dame du Scex
 Born 567 Grenoble, FR
 Died 13 Sept 629 (652) Remiremont, FR
 Feast Day 13 September
 Traveled with St. Eustace to Luxeuil in 614 from St. Maurice
 Founded Remiremont Abbey, first abbot



- 72 St. Gall(us), C
 From Ireland
 Born 550 c.a.
 Died 646
 Feast Day 16 Oct
 Relics in Abbey of St. Gall in crypt under east apse
 Often depicted with a bear with a piece of wood



- 73 St. Protasius (Proasius, Prothasius) of Lausanne, B
 Bishop of Lausanne 651(2) c.a.
 Died ~650 mid-7th century (652) (or 507?)
 Feast Day 6 Nov
 Buried Church of St. Prex- no visible sign of tomb in church

- 74 St. Quilisinda, V
 OSB nun in Brig, CH
 Died 650 c.a.
 Feast Day 22 August
 From Holy Lexicon by JE Stadler 1858- 1882

- 75 St. Lonochil (Leonogisil, Longils), C
 Born in Switzerland
 Died 29 Mar 653 LeMans, FR
 Feast Day 13 June
 Baptized and ordained in FR 620



- 76 St. Magnus of Fussen, C
 Came with Columbanus and Gall (or was born in St. Gallen)
 Born 582
 Died 655 (627 or 749 or 722)
 Feast Day 6 Sept
 Very confusing and confounded story
 Relics Mang Basilica, Fussen



- 77 St. Theodoro
 Companion of St. Magnus
 Feast Day 6 Sept
 He and Magnus joined up with Gall in Arbon, CH
 Traveled with Magnus to DE
 Co-founded Kempton and Fussen Abbeys
 Supposedly wrote a book on life of Magnus



- 78 St. Germanus of Granfelden, M abbot
 First Abbot of Moutier-Grandval Monastery
 Born 612 Trier, DE
 Died 666
 Feast Day 21 Feb



Martyred with St. Rondoald of Grandval
 Crosier in Musee Jurassien d'art it d'Listone in Delemont
 Relics at Delemont



- 79 St. Rondoald of Grandval, M
 Monk at Moutier-Grandval Monastery
 Died 21 Feb 666
 Martyred with St. Germanus of Granfelden
 Feast Day 21 Feb
 Relics at Delemont



- 80 St. Wandrille (Wandregisil), C abbot
 Hermit a St. Ursanne (JU) for awhile and at Romain-Moutier (VD)
 Born near Verdun, FR ~600
 Died 22 July 668 Fontenelle, FR
 Initially married
 Established the great monastery of Fontenelle

- 81 Bl. Chilmegisil, B of Avenches
 Reigned ~670, although some sources say 532

- 82 St. Haberilla, her
 Hermitess near Mehrerau, CH (now Austria)
 Died late 7th century
 Feast Day 30 Jan



- 83 St. Amatus (Aimé) of Sion, abbot
 Abbot Breuil (FR), Bishop Sion
 Died 690
 Feast Day 13 Sept
- Holweck says he is of Sens, FR and that he is unknown in CH. But, there is a picture of him in the Cathedral of Sion. Possible confusion w/ Amatus of St-Maurice in the picture?

- 84 St. Placidus of Disentis, M
 Co-founded Disentis Abbey w/ St. Sigisbert
 Lawyer and rich landowner
 Died 11 July 720- martyred
 Feast Day 11 July
 Relics in Abbey



- 85 St. Sigisbert, abbot
 Co-founded Disentis Abbey w/ St. Placidus
 A Frank
 Died 730 c.a.
 Feast Day 11 July
 Relics in Abbey- 11 July procession
 Relics in Cathedral of Chur



- 86 St. Adalbero of Disentis, M abbot
 Second abbot of Disentis
 Died c.a. 740
 Feast Day 3 Aug
 Brought the treasures of the monastery to Zurich during a Hun invasion
 Killed by the barbarians
 Relics in the altar of Disentis

- 87 St. Pirminus (Pirmin), B
 Bishop
 Born in Spain 700
 In Reichenau from 724- 727
 Started Hornbach 742
 Died 3 Nov 753
 Feast Day 3 Nov
 Tomb in Hornbach Abbey, DE
 Helped rebuild Disentis Abbey
 Relics in the Jesuit Church of Innsbruck



- 88 St. Othmar, abbot
 First Abbot of St. Gallen
 Born 689 in Germany
 Died 759
 Feast Day 16 Nov
 Depicted with crozier and wine barrel
 Tomb in St. Gallen Abbey- crypt under western apse



- 89 St. Ursicinus II, B abbot



Bishop of Chur between 754-760
 Died 760
 Feast Day 2 Oct
 Abbot of Disentis
 Tomb in Cathedral of Chur



90 Bl. Remigius (Remedius), BC abbot
 Founded Schönenwerth (SO) monastery
 Died 29 Mar 783 (803)
 Feast Day 20 Mar
 Bishop of Strasbourg
 Nephew of St. Odilia



91 St. Alteus (Altheus, Althaeo), B
 Bishop of Valais
 Feast Day 23 September
 Received Papal bull favoring exception of St. Maurice Abbey 780
 Abt of St-Maurice, 786-804



92 Bl. Udalricus (Ulrich), B
 Bishop of Lausanne
 Contemporary of Charlemagne, late 700's, early 800's
 Feast Day 19 April
 Brother of SS Hildegardis, Adelinda and Gerold
 There was a B. Udalricus in Lausanne in 690, but must have been a predecessor

93 St. Notburga of Buel
 Scotch-Irish descent living in Klettgau, DE west of Schaffhausen
 Born around 796 Scotland
 Died 26 Jan 840
 Feast Day 26 Jan at Buel
 Born nine children (one died young) who all became saints
 Son Eglisius is related to Eglisau, ZH in CH and daughter Hixta (Dixta, Hirta)
 related to Jestetten, DE-a chapel dedicated to her existed until 1833



94 St. Florinus (Florian) of Remus, Pr
 Priest
 Died 856
 Feast Day 17 Nov
 Tomb in parish church of St. Peter in Ramosch, GR
 Relics Florinskiche in Koblenz- no longer.
 Relics Regensburg, DE



95 St. Meinrad, M her
 Born 797 c.a. Rottenburg am Neckar, DE
 Died 861
 Feast Day 21 Jan
 Martyr
 Educated Reichenau Abbey in Lake Constance
 Einsiedeln means "Our Lady of Hermits"
 Often shown with two ravens
 Relics in Einsiedeln



96 St. Marcellus (Moengal) of St. Gall, rel
 Scottish teacher of Bl. Notker Balbulus
 Born Ireland (or Scotland)
 Died c869
 Feast Day 27 September



97 St. Iso (Ysone) of St. Gallen, rel
 Teacher of Notker Balbulus and Tuotilo
 Born 830 Thurgau
 Died 14 May 871 Granfelden Monastery

98 St. Findan of Rheinau, her
 Walled in recluse
 Born 803/4 Leinster, Ireland
 Died 879 (827)
 Feast Day 15 Nov
 Relics in Findan's altar in Church in Rheinau



99 St. Eusebius of Gall (Rankweil), M her
 From Ireland
 Died 884



Feast Day 30/31 Jan
 30 yrs. hermit on Mt. St. Victor in Vorarlberg
 Martyr- scythe
 Relics in Church in Brederis, AT



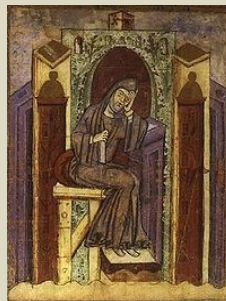
100 St. Victor von Tomils, PrM
 Priest, Martyr Graubünden
 Born 840 Tomils (current Tumeagl)
 Died 887
 Feast Day 28 May
 Relics behind main altar of Pfarrkirche in Cazis.



101 St. Richardis, secular canness
 Married to Charles the Fat, Holy Roman Empress
 Born c. 840
 Died 18 Sept 895
 Feast Day 10 Sept
 Lay abbess of religious houses in
 Säkingen (DE) and Zürich (Felix & Regula)



102 Bl. Notker Balbulus, rel C
 The Stammerer of St. Gallen
 Born 840 Jonschwil, St. Gallen, CH
 Died 6 April 912
 Feast Day 7 April
 Relics in Monastery Church



103 St. Tutilo (Tuotilo), rel
 Irish trained in St. Gall
 Best know for his music and painting
 Died 915
 Feast Day 28 Mar
 Buried in St. Catherine Chapel (or Chapel of St. Tutilo) in St. Gall

104 St. Wiborada, VM
 Anchoress in St. Gallen
 From Klingna (Klingnau), Aargau
 Died 1 May 926
 Feast Day 1 May (formally 2 May)
 Relics ???
 First officially canonized female saint
 Only a very small window had Wiborada to «the outside world» and with this she could pass on
 her advice to others. The small window on the wall can still be seen today in the St. Mangen Church.



105 Bl. Benno of Einsiedeln (Metz), BC
 Bishop and co-founder of Einsiedeln, Hermit
 Born late 9th century in Bayern, DE
 Died 940
 Feast Day 3 Aug
 Relics in Einsiedeln, found in 1617
 Supposed buried in the Chapel of Our Lady



106 Bl. Rachildis of Saint-Gall, V her
 Anchoress in St. Gall
 Born Fricktal, Aargau
 Died 946
 Feast Day 23 Nov

Died 24 Nov 1989 Zürich
Engineer, businessman, founder of the Limmat Foundation

Layperson of the Diocese of Ipiales
Layperson of the Society of Bethlehem Mission Immensee
Born 04 Apr 1936 Näfels, GL, CH
Died 09 Sept 1990 El Sande, Guachavés, Nariño, Columbia
Martyr for the faith

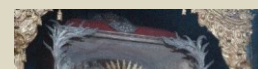

Spiritual friend of Bl. Henry Suso

- 247 Eucharistic Miracle Ettiswil
1447 - a woman stole a pix containing a big consecrated Host. The Host was found near a fence, thanks to a herd of pigs that wouldn't go further. The Host was divided into seven pieces: six were joined together so that they looked like a bright flower. The priest picked up the six sections, but when reaching for the seventh, it disappeared into the ground. A chapel was built on the spot.
